Every person who submits plans or specifications and every owner agrees that such person or owner will not bring any action or suit against the Released Parties to recover any damages in connection with the approval of such plans and/or specifications and hereby release, discharge, and covenants not to sue the Released Parties for all claims, demands, and causes of action arising out of or in connection such review and approval of the plans and/or specifications.

The undersigned accept full responsibility for the design and implementation of a properly functioning drainage plan for the property located at Lot \_\_\_\_\_ in HHC, which drainage plan must not adversely affect the surrounding properties, including but not limited to the adjacent lots and golf course.
